Subject: Parental contribution by direct debit

Dear parent(s)/guardian(s),

We would like to collect the parental contribution for the school year 2024-2025 by direct debit. Therefore, we are giving you this letter with the request to fill out the form on the back and hand it in to the teacher. The parental contribution next year for groups 1 to 8 (TPO) is \in 66,= We offer you the possibility to pay in one or three installments.

Why a voluntary parental contribution?

From the voluntary parental contribution, the Parent Council provides and organizes various activities within the school. The parent council also supports the school with the IPC (thematic) education and the tpo (bilingual education). You can think of:

- School photographer
- Sports Day
- Festivities such as "Sinterklaas", Christmas and Easter
- The 'Avond Vierdaagse' walking event
- School gardens
- Read-aloud morning / read-aloud breakfast
- Fee photographer (takes pictures of the play, field days and parties)
- Farewell to Group 8
- IPC activities
- English workshops/lessons and activities

The Parent Council also works with the school to take care of the playground and other activities within the school.

Who administers the parental contribution?

This is done by the Parent Council on behalf of the school's parent association. The Parent Council prepares a budget each year. The budget for this school year can be found on the website www.voorhof.eglantierdelft.nl (under the heading parents - parent council - meetings/budget).

Does your financial situation not allow you to pay the parental contribution?

The municipality of Delft offers a facility, with which you can apply for an allowance for costs such as the parental contribution. Is your joint income lower than \in 2201.00 per month for married/cohabiting couples or \in 1541.00 for singles? In that case, the parent can buy a Delft pass for \in 5. Resident children then get a free pass. On the child's pass, from August onwards, 50 euro will be charged for payment of the parental contribution. Fill in the number of your child's Delftpas on the back of this letter, the school will then receive your parental contribution via the municipality. For more information, see school fees via Delftpas on the municipality's website.

Please complete the back of this letter separately for each child and hand it in to the teacher by Friday 14 June.
