

This is the guide of Integrated Child Centre De Eglantier (IKC).

Children, teachers, teaching staff and parents/caregivers all learn and work together at the IKC. In this IKC calendar, you will find practical information from IKC De Eglantier and what you can expect from us as IKC. For example: how we deal with special leave, trips and all important dates.

Where it says 'parent(s)', you may also read caregiver(s).

The IKC Eglantier in short

The IKC Eglantier is a cooperation between Stichting Librijn Openbaar Onderwijs (Public Education Foundation) and Kinderopvang Morgen. Librijn is responsible for the public primary schools in Delft and Rijswijk.

Kinderopvang Morgen is available for children between 6 weeks to 12 years at many locations in Rijswijk, The Hague, het Westland, and Delft. IKC De Eglantier provides a playgroup, a day care centre, pre-school care, lunch break care, and afterschool care (including holidays), as well as primary education.

At IKC De Eglantier, we work based on a jointly supported pedagogical and educational vision performed by one team. We do this together for the benefit of all the children.

Professionals and parents work together in the IKC to give support tailored to the development of the children. Parents and children are allowed to make their own choices from the services offered at the IKC Eglantier. This makes it easier for parents to combine work and care between 7:30 to 18:30.

We strive for the optimal upbringing and inclusive education

for each child. We do this by providing a cohesive curriculum of continuous developmental trajectories for children from 0 to 12 years based on the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) and Bilingual Primary Education (TPO). At the childcare, we work with the program Early Bird, which introduces the children to English in a playful manner.

The International Primary Curriculum is an integrated, thematic, and creative curriculum for children aged 4 to 12 years, focusing on creative and social studies subjects. The IPC is composed in such a way that it provides insight and improves learning.

Bilingual Primary Education is a pilot project from the Ministry of Education in which we have been chosen to participate. In the school year, 2022-2023, all grades will receive education in English for approximately 30% of the time.

VISIE



IKC De Eglantier is the place for education, childcare, upbringing, and children's development from 6 weeks to 12 years. We guide the children in a safe pedagogical environment on their journey to becoming citizens of the world. We do this by offering personal skills.

We enter the world!

Action-oriented learning, cooperative work forms and goal-oriented work on (individual) learning needs are central to our (educational) resources.

To emphasise global citizenship, next to the basic subjects such as mathematics and language, we work with the International Primary Curriculum (IPC), and we teach English to all children. To teach the children to become owners of their educational process, every child develops a portfolio in cooperation with teachers and parent(s).


The children in the Eglantier are diverse in nationality. The international background and the relatively green location of our

buildings mean that culture and nature are two pillars on which the IKC De Eglantier builds: before, during and after school. This is evident from the annual theatrical shows, educative excursions, green schoolyards, school gardens, the greenhouse, and a wide range of after school activities.

At IKC De Eglantier, we work on an integrated curriculum with great attention to continuous development and shared responsibility for learning and educating.

Daily activities

The IKC is open from 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Parent(s) may enter the day care centre and nursery school to say goodbye. In groups 1 to 8 of the school, we expect parents to say goodbye to their child outside before 8.30 a.m. This promotes the independence of the child and ensures a quiet start to the lessons.

In the morning, short messages can be passed on to the pedagogical staff member or to the teacher. There is no opportunity for longer conversations, although an appointment can be made in the morning for a conversation at another time

When the bell rings to go home at 12 noon and 3 p.m., the children come outside by themselves or with the teacher. The children who go to the after-school care are picked up after school to go to the day care. The teachers of groups 1 and 2 see to it that the children are picked up.

When a child is picked up by someone other than the parents, please notify the teacher or pedagogical staff about this.

Attendance

Call in sick

If your child is unexpectedly unable to come to the IKC due to illness or family circumstances, please inform us before 8:15 a.m. via Schoudercom and for the day care via the app.

Absence

If your child is absent at our IKC without notice, we will contact you around 9 a.m.

Your child's absence is carefully registered with the reason for the absence. The teacher will talk to you if your child is regularly late or absent. Agreements are made in this conversation. If the situation does not improve after discussions with the teacher, the location director invites you for a follow-up interview. If the situation does not improve after that, the IKC will report this omission to the attendance officer. From the age of 5, all children are subject to compulsory education and must attend school every day.

Leave of absence

You can request a leave day for a child in case of serious circumstances, such as a move, a marriage of a family member or an anniversary. You can download forms "request for exemption from school attendance" (verzoek om vrijstelling schoolbezoek) from the website. An application form must be submitted to the location director at least one month before the desired leave.

Join in the discussion and help

Parental involvement

When parents and IKC team work well together, children will feel more comfortable at school and day care. We, therefore, stand for an educational partnership.

Parent(s), teachers, and pedagogical staff are

expected to act in the child's best interest. Together we feel responsible for the development of children. Good collaboration is important in this. To ensure this, we make our IKC as accessible as possible for you. The basis for good communication between the various parties is trust, mutual understanding and respect. Sometimes it is necessary to maintain more regular contact between IKC and parents/guardians. This can promote the development of children. It may also be required to practise (extra) teaching material with your child.

We also expect a contribution from the parent(s) to your child's development. Parents who register their children enter into an educational partnership to be jointly responsible for their development. It may be a pleasant experience to talk with other parents about school business, things you notice in your child's development, or chat with other parents. Once a month, you will get the chance to do just that in the 'parent room'.

We assume that you are present at moments when your child's development is discussed such as the contact evenings, information evenings and the portfolio interviews. An information evening will take place at the start of the new school year. Parent evenings on specific topics are also organised. During portfolio discussions, you will discuss the portfolios with your child.

We organise many activities for the children to be involved with skills and acquire knowledge in different ways. We regularly need the help of parent(s)—for example, technical lessons, trips, traffic lessons, sports tournaments and the annual sports day.

Delftpas

The Delftpas can be applied for by everyone, even if you do not live in Delft. Delftpas is valid from 1 March 2022 through 28 February 2023. With Delftpas, you can experience fun activities in Delft and the region, go to the movies or a museum for free.

After school activities

The children are given the opportunity to participate in various after-school activities. Various courses are offered in the field of music, technology and culture. For example, a typing course, learn to play the guitar, or yoga lessons. You will receive more information about this, and you can register your child during the school year. For the after-school activities, external people are hired by the IKC. The activities are the responsibility of the IKC..

Bicycles

Grades 5 and up regularly go on the road with their bicycles under the supervision of the teacher and parent(s), for example, for an outing, school garden or traffic lessons.

The bicycle must, of course, be technically sound. Cycling is not allowed on the playground. At the beginning of the school year, the classes discuss which children may or may not come to school by bicycle daily.

There is only limited space for the IKC to store bicycles. That is why only children who live more than fifteen minutes' walk from school can come by bike or when a trip by bike is planned.

If your child does come to school by bicycle, we ask you to put it in the appropriate racks. Make sure that the bike is locked. The IKC is not liable for damage or theft.

guidelines set up by the government and the RIVM. If necessary, we will notify the parents via Schoudercom and the KDV Morgen app to make adjustments to the daily routine.

Drop off and pick up (school run)

The safety of the children is paramount. That is why we ask you to bring your child by car only in emergencies. If this is not possible, we request that you park your car in the designated parking spaces in such a way that the other traffic is not obstructed and the safety is not endangered. The police are notified of violations of the parking bans. The IKC regularly ask the police to supervise.

For the safety of the children, there is a drive-in ban at the Ina Boudier-Bakkerstraat between 8.15-8.45 and 14.45-15.15. At the Roland Holstlaan, we ask you not to stop in front of the R.H. building. There are enough parking spaces on the Roland Holstlaan and the Jan Campertlaan.

Educational trips

We try to make an educational trip with most IPC themes. This is made known to parent(s) in advance via Schoudercom.

child seat. We thereby adhere to the guidelines for

safe transportation. In transport by other parents, we

ask you to give your child a car seat or booster seat (if present) for use during transport during the trip. Many trips can only take place with the help of parent(s).

Please try to free up time for this. The childcare has a

protocol for outings. You can ask the pedagogical staff

what that entails.

3 If you are available, you can take your child to the Emergency Department;

4 If you are not available, we will contact the G.P. surgery;

5 In severe cases, we immediately call the emergency services and parents;

Gruiten (fruits and vegetables)

At IKC, we encourage healthy eating. During the break, we aim to ensure that children eat and drink healthily. **We have 'Gruit'-days at school three times a week, on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. This means that at school, only fruit and vegetables are eaten during the small break.**

We celebrate your child's birthday in class and at day care. Of course, your child will have the opportunity to treat. A small amount is desirable, and we strongly support a healthy treat for the children and teachers/pedagogical staff. Children only give treats to their class and teacher.

Head lice

Unfortunately, children sometimes have head lice. We request you inform the IKC when your child has

First aid

Should your child be involved in an accident at school, then the procedure is as follows:

- 1 Minor injuries are treated by one of the teachers or pedagogical staff. Several teachers have a first-aid certificate (BHV) and will assist if necessary;
- 2 The school will give first aid in case of severe injuries and will immediately phone the parents;

Insurance

IKC De Eglantier has taken out collective accident insurance for all children, employees, volunteers, and helping parents. This insurance is valid during IKC times and for all activities organised by the school, such as workweek and trips. This insurance does not apply to damaged personal property, such as bicycles, clothing and glasses. For this, you must take out a W.A. insurance yourself.

Lost and Found objects

Lost and found items are collected in special baskets at every location. We advise you not to let your child bring any valuables to school. Found objects that are not collected will be displayed in the hall for at least a week before a holiday. If the owner has not yet claimed them, we will donate them to a good cause, or they will be thrown away.

Lunch break care

Most children eat lunch at school in the afternoon. During lunch hour, the children can have lunch and play between noon and 1 p.m. under the supervision of assistants. The school provides the organisation of the lunch break care. You pay by direct debit. For the

Homework

Grade 5 and up receive weekly homework. The homework consists of preparing for spelling tests, presentations or a book review and making assignments.

The teacher will ascribe at least one test per week to the children. In groups 7 and 8, the children have a planner to write down the tests and homework to plan. When your child uses after-school care, homework support is possible.

IKC guide

The IKC has published an IKC guide (part A), in which you can read about the goals we pursue and how we intend to achieve them. The school guide is provided digitally to the parents.

You can find any updated versions on the website. This calendar (part B) is updated annually and handed out to all parents at the start of the school year.

day/per child. The costs of incidental lunch care costs
are settled twice a year, in January and in September.

Mobile phones

In the IKC, the use of mobile phones is prohibited.
If there are calamities or urgent messages for your
child, you may call the IKC phone number. We can
imagine that you like to give your child a mobile to
take to school. When children bring a mobile phone,
they must remain switched off and in their school bag
during school hours. The mobile may also be given to
the class teacher for safekeeping. The school is not
liable for loss, theft or damage to the mobile phone.

Physical education

Grades 1 and 2 have physical exercise or dance in
the playroom. They exercise in their underwear with

sneakers. Groups 3 to 8 receive physical education
twice a week from a professional teacher. Sneakers, a
gym suit or shorts with a shirt are required. For safety
reasons, the children wear no jewellery, and long hair
needs to be worn in a tail or braid.

If your child cannot participate in the gym class,
you must notify the teacher via Schouder.com.

The groups that have gymnastics at 8.30 a.m. and
1 p.m. are expected at the gym room on that morning
or afternoon; they do not go to school first. Children
who use pre-school care are brought to the gym room.
The door opens at 8.20 a.m. and 12.50 p.m. The kids
must be ready to start the lesson at 8.30 and 13.00.
The children who finish gym class at noon and 3 p.m.
can be picked up in the gym room. After-school care
will, if necessary, pick up the children at 3 p.m. in the
gym room.

Parents with a low income can also use the Delft-
pas to pay (part of) the costs of sports and culture.
The Jeugdsportfonds (€ 325) and the Jeugdcultuur-
fonds (€ 450) contribute to the costs of sport and
culture. You can apply for this contribution separately
or both through the school management.

Play area

During the lunch break (12.00 to 13.00), the square is intended for the children who have lunch at school. The other children can enter the square at 12.45 at the I.B. building and 12.55 at the R.H. building. After school, the square is used for after-school care.

At the I.B. building, children who do not use the childcare are also allowed to play on the square. We expect that they will adhere to the rules. At the R.H. building, the square is also used for childcare after school, and it is not allowed to play freely after school.

Protocol

Protocols have been drawn up within the IKC. This includes a domestic violence protocol, behaviour, cycling, lice, pedagogical plan of approach and mourning. The protocols can be viewed by appointment with the management.

The education inspection report and the GGD report can be found on our websites.

Report cards

The children do not receive a report card at the day care and in grades 1 and 2. The children are observed during their play based on the "KIJK!" development lines. The development lines are used as a starting

point for the annual parent interview at the day care and the 10-minute interviews with grades 1 and 2.

In groups 1 to 8, there will be an introductory meeting around September. In the introductory meeting, we discuss a list of topics such as work attitude, independence and your child's talents. Agreements for the future are made with your daughter or son. The first report talk will take place in February, and you will receive the second report card in July.

In addition, you may contact the teacher(s) for information after school. Please make an appointment for this. Teachers may also take the initiative for an interview.

Suspension and expulsion

In consultation with Stichting Librijn, the IKC has drawn up clear rules for suspension and expulsion in the event of unacceptable behaviour of children and parent(s) and the school's inability to deal with certain situations or behaviour. We use a behavioural protocol for this. These protocols can be found on our website. By intolerable behaviour, we mean:

- refusing to listen;
- refusing to participate in activities;
- being rude or cheeky; insulting, discriminating, cursing, swearing, threatening;

- fighting, hitting and kicking;
- bullying;
- committing vandalism or theft;
- coming late to school regularly.

By "School's inability to deal with certain situations or behaviour", we mean:

The situation that arises when the school, in general, can no longer provide a responsible, adequate answer to the specific instruction and educational needs of a child.

Suspension means denial of access to the school for a day.

Expulsion means that the child is deregistered from the school. The right to be heard will be applied in all cases. The competent authority will be involved in the procedure. A definitive expulsion can only occur if the school's management has ensured that another school or institution is willing to admit the child, with a maximum period of eight weeks.

This suspension and expulsion policy also applies if a parent shows aggressive and intimidating behaviour towards other parents, teachers, management, other staff, or the children.

In the event of a violation of the law, we, as IKC, will always involve the police.

Toilet trained

We assume that children who go to primary school are toilet trained. It is normal for children of kindergarten age to have an "accident", so provide spare clothing. If your child is not toilet trained for medical reasons, we will try to find a solution together.

As a school, we only change children when an "accident" has occurred.

Use of medication

Children are with us for several hours a day. During this time, they may need to take prescribed medication. It can also happen that children experience pain that can seemingly be solved easily by painkillers (brought along). Because medicines can sometimes have unexpected consequences, we handle them with great care. Staff members do not administer (light) medication to children unless parents request this in writing, the staff members have been instructed, and agreements have been made. The staff members of the IKC are not liable for any side effects that may occur due to the medicine/medical action administered by their staff or forgetting to administer the medicine.

Therefore, the teachers and pedagogical staff only give children medicine if there is a signed statement from parents or attending physicians.
