IKC De Eglantier Voorhof in short

IKC De Eglantier Voorhof consists of a collaboration between Stichting Librijn Public Education and Stichting Rijswijkse Kinderopvang (SRK). Librijn is responsible for the public primary education in Delft and Rijswijk.

Stichting Rijswijkse Kinderopvang is available for children from 6 weeks up to 12 years at a large number of locations in Rijswijk, The Hague and Delft. At IKC De Eglantier Voorhof there is a nursery (KDV), kindergarten, pre-school care (VSO), in-school care (TSO) and after-school care (NSO) in addition to education.

At IKC De Eglantier Voorhof, we work on the basis of one joint pedagogical-educational vision that is carried out by one team: We enter the world! We do this together for all children.

Professionals and parents work together in the IKC to give support tailored to the development of the children. Parents and children are given the opportunity to make their own choices from the services offered at the IKC Eglantier Voorhof. This makes it easier for parents to combine work and care between 7:30 to 18:30.

We strive for optimal upbringing and education for each child. We do this by providing a cohesive curriculum of continuous learning trajectories for children from 0 to 12 years based on the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) and Bilingual Primary Education (TPO). In the Day-care we work with the Early Bird program, to become familiar with English in a playful way.

The International Primary Curriculum is an integrated, thematic and creative curriculum for children aged 2.5 to 12 years which focusses on the creative and social studies subjects. The IPC is compiled with high standards in terms of learning.

Bilingual Primary Education (TPO) is a pilot project from the Ministry of Education in which we have chosen to participate. Starting the school year 2018-2019, 30 percent of teaching time in groups 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be conducted in English. In the other classes, the teaching time in English is 15 percent.

VISION



Tailored learning, cooperative methods, purposeful learning and focus on (individual) learning needs are central to our curriculum.

To emphasize the global citizenship, we work with the International Primary Curriculum (IPC) and we teach English to all children from preschool age, next to the basic subjects such as mathematics and language. To teach the children to become owners of their own education, every child develops a portfolio in cooperation with teachers and parents.

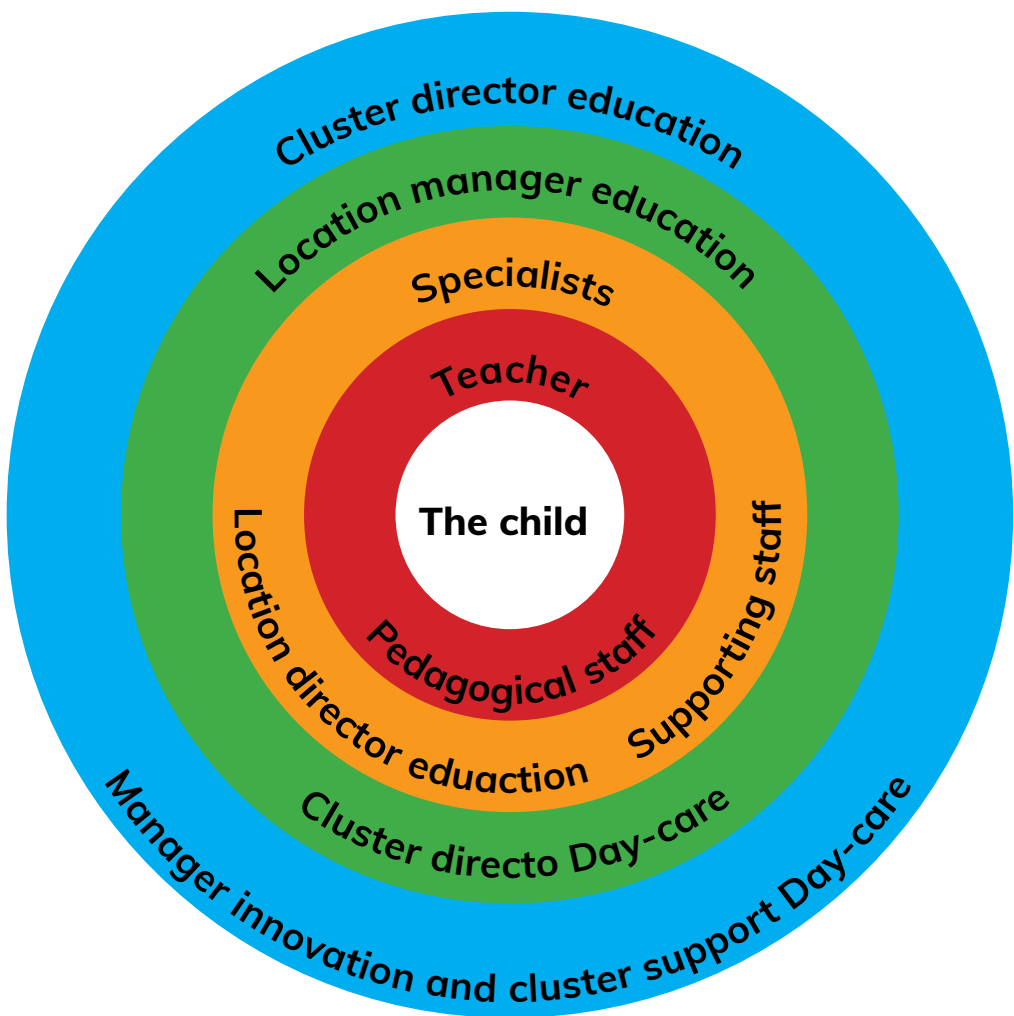
The children in the Eglantier Voorhof are diverse in nationality. The international background and the relatively green

Daily activities

The IKC is open from 7.30 am to 6.30 pm. At the nursery, the playgroup, and the groups 1 and 2 of the school, parent(s) can come in to say goodbye and share necessary information with the pedagogical staff or the teacher. In the morning there is no opportunity to hold longer conversations, but in the morning an appointment can be made for a conversation at another time.

In groups 3 to 8 we expect parents to say goodbye to their child before 8.30 am. This promotes the independence of the child and ensures a quiet start of the lessons. If you would like to discuss something with the teacher, you are of course welcome to make

an appointment. Before school time it is not possible to discuss anything with the teacher.

When the bell rings at 12 a.m. and 3 p.m. to go home, the children leave the school themselves or with the teacher. The children who go to after-school care are picked up after school to go to the location. The teachers of groups 1 and 2 ensure that the children are picked up.

When a child is picked up by someone other than the parents, this must be passed on to the teacher or the pedagogical staff.

Presence

Call in sick

Should your child unexpectedly be unable to come to the IKC due to illness or family circumstances, please inform us by telephone **before 8.30 am**.

Absence

If your child is not present at school without notification, we will contact you at around 9 am. The absence of your child is carefully registered with a reason. The teacher will talk to you if your child is regularly late or absent. Agreements are made in this conversation. If the situation does not improve after conversations with the teacher, the location manager invites you for a follow-up conversation. If the situation does not improve after that, the IKC reports this omission to the school attendance officer.

Children from 5 years and older are subject to compulsory education and they have to go to school every day.

Leave of absence

You can apply for a day off for a child, for important circumstances, such as a move, a marriage of a family member or an anniversary. Forms 'request for exemption from school visits' can be obtained from the teacher or downloaded from the website. An application form must be submitted to the location manager at least one month before the desired leave.

Joining & helping

Parent involvement

When parents and IKC team work well together, children will feel at home more quickly at school and at childcare. We therefore stand for partnership.

Parents, teachers and pedagogical staff are expected to act in the interests of the child. We therefore feel jointly responsible for the development of children. Good cooperation is important for this. To ensure a good cooperation, we make our IKC as accessible as possible for you. The basis for good communication between the various parties is trust, mutual understanding and respect. Sometimes it is necessary to maintain a more regular contact between IKC and parents. This can promote the development of children. You may also need to practice (extra) material with your child.

We further expect a contribution to the development of your child from all parents. Every parent who registers his child enters the partnership to be jointly responsible for the development of the child. We expect you to be present at contact nights, information evenings and during biennial portfolio interviews. An information evening will take place at the start of the new school year. In addition, parents' evenings are organized on specific topics. During portfolio discussions, you will discuss this with your child.

We organize many activities for the children so that they can get involved in acquiring knowledge in different ways. For this we regularly need the help of parents. You can think of: science lessons, trips, traffic lessons, sports tournaments and the annual sports day.

Parent contribution education

The school requests a voluntary financial contribution for extra facilities and activities in addition to the curriculum. For the education of IKC De Eglantier Voorhof, the parental contribution is spent on:

- The IPC outings;
- The food and drinks and the rent of the sports field for the sports day;
- The rent of the school gardens for group 6;

- The decoration of parties like the Sinterklaas celebration and the Christmas party;
- The payment of the photographer who photographs the children during sports day, theatre nights, Sinterklaas celebration and other activities.
- For the classes that have bilingual primary education (TPO) some extra activities are organized.

For group 1 to 4 (TPO classes) the parental contribution is € 46 and for groups 5 to 8 € 36 per year. You can pay via Stichting ouderraad De Eglantier, NL65 INGB 0001673458.

Costs childcare

Childcare (nursery, toddler care and pre-school and after-school care) is covered by the Childcare Act. For the childcare you sign a contract with the Stichting Rijswijkse Kinderopvang. Working parent(s) are in principle entitled to childcare allowance and pay an income-related parental contribution.

After school activities

The children are given the opportunity to take part in various after-school activities. Some courses are offered in the field of music, technology and culture like a typing course, guitar lessons or yoga classes. You will receive more information about this during the school year and then you can register your child. For the after-school activities, external providers are hired by the IKC, but the activities are the responsibility of the IKC.

The youth sport fund (€ 225) and the youth culture fund (€ 450) also contribute to the costs of sport and culture for children from low-income families. You can apply for this allowance separately or both via the school management.

Communication

Letters, newsletters, photo albums of our house photographer of activities are sent digitally as much as possible via a school-based communication tool. It is therefore important that the IKC is aware of your email address. When changing an email address or if you require information about the IKC, please contact: directie@eglantierdelft.nl and / or plaatsingen@kin-deropvang-plein.nl

First aid

If an accident happens to your child in the IKC, then we act as follows:

- 1 In case of minor injuries one of the teachers or pedagogical staff the child, if necessary, supported by one of the school first aid officers (BedrijfsHulp-Verleners (BHV));
- 2 If it is more serious, we will do what is necessary and call the parent(s);
- 3 If you are available, you can take your child to the Emergency Department;
- 4 If you are not available, we will go with your child to the Emergency Department;

- 5 In serious cases we immediately call the emergency services and the parent(s);
- 6 Accidents are registered by us.

Found objects

Found objects are collected at each location in special baskets. We advise you not to give any valuables to your child. Items that are not collected will be displayed in the hall at least one week before a holiday. If they are not taken away by the owner afterwards, we donate them to a good cause or they are thrown away.

Unfortunately, head lice sometimes occurs in children. We ask you to inform the IKC when your child has head lice. We can then inform the other parents. After each holiday, each group has parents check all children for head lice. If head lice is detected during the check with your child, you will be approached by the teacher or pedagogical staff member. You should then treat your child at home.

Homework

From group 5 on, the children receive weekly home-work. The homework consists of preparing dictations, presentations or a book review and making assignments.

The teacher will announce a test at least a week in advance to the children. In groups 7 and 8 the children have a homework planner to write down the tests and the homework. If your child uses after-school care, homework assistance is possible.

IKC guide

The IKC has published an IKC Guide (Part A), in which you can read about the goals we pursue and how we intend to achieve them. The guide is provided digitally to the parents.

Any new versions can be found on the website. This calendar (part B) is updated annually and handed out to all parents at the beginning of the school year.

Insurance

IKC De Eglantier Voorhof has taken out collective accident insurance for all children, employees and helping parents. This insurance is valid during IKC times and

for all activities organized by the school, such as work week and school trips. This insurance is not applicable to damaged personal belongings, such as bicycles, clothing and glasses. For this, you must take out a W.A. insurance yourself.

Lunch at school (TSO)

Most children eat lunch at school. During lunch hour, the children can have lunch and play between 12.00 and 13.00, with the assistance of the lunch staff. The organisation of the lunch care is provided by school. You pay by direct debit.

For the incidental stay the rate is: € 3,- per time/ per child and € 1.60 with a subscription per year/ per day/ per child. The costs are calculated twice a year, in January and in September.

Registering and deregistering for incidental lunch at school should be done by telephone between 8.00 and 11.00 in the morning at the TSO coordinator, Ms Annette, or by sending an e-mail to: tso@eglantierdelft.nl before 11 am.

If you are interested in a role of a lunch staff member, you can register with the TSO coordinator.

Medicine use

Children are with us for several hours a day. In this period it may occur that they have to take prescribed medication. It can also happen that children get pain that can be solved by (brought) painkillers in an apparently simple way. Because medicines can sometimes have unexpected effects, we are very careful about this. With regard to medication use, agreements can be made for this, between parents and the IKC. IKC employees will only give children medication when there is a signed statement from parents and/or attending physicians.

Physical Education

Groups 1 and 2 gym or dance in the small gym room. They exercise in their underwear with sneakers. Groups 3 to 8 receive physical education twice a week from a specialist teacher. Sport shoes, a gymnastic outfit or shorts with a shirt are mandatory. For safety reasons, the children do not wear jewellery. Longer hair should for that reason be worn in a tail or braid. If your child can not participate in the PE class, you must report this to the teacher via email or a letter. The groups that have physical education at 8.30 and 13.00 are expected at the gymnastics hall on that morning or afternoon, they do not go to school first.

Children who use the preschool care are taken to the gym. The door opens at 8.20 and 12.50. The children must be ready at 8.30 and 13.00. The children who are finished with the physical education at noon and 3 pm can be picked up at the gymnastics hall. The after-school care staff fetches the children at 15.00 from the gymnastics hall if necessary.

Playground

During the lunch break (12.00 to 13.00) the square is reserved for the children who eat lunch at school. The children who eat lunch at home, may enter the playground at 12.45 pm at the IB building and at 12.55 pm at the RH building. After school, the playground is used by after-school care. Children who do not make use of the childcare may also play on the playground of the IB building. We expect that they will comply with the outdoor play rules. The RH building playground is also in use by the after-school childcare and cannot be entered after school hours.

Protocols

Protocols have been drawn up within the IKC. Think of a protocol for domestic violence, behaviour, cycling,

Report cards

The children do not get report cards at the childcare and in the kindergarten groups. The children are observed during play according to the 'KIJKI' development lines. The development lines are used as a starting point for the 10-minute parent-teacher talks. In groups 3 to 8 the children receive a report card three times a year. The report card is also discussed with you. We will invite you to speak with the teacher(s) about the progress and developments of your child during a 10 minute-talk. You can of course also contact the teacher(s) for information after school. Please make an appointment for this. Teachers may also take the initiative for an talk when necessary.

School milk

During school time you can choose to subscribe to school milk. This product is stored in a large refrigerator with us. The delivery is provided by Campina,

who sends the customer a giro collection form. The administration is run by Campina not the school. With questions you can contact Campina on telephone number: 088 116 80 06, or on the website www.schoolmelk.nl.

School run

The safety of the children is paramount. That is why we ask you to do the school run by car only in exceptional cases. When it is not possible for you to bring your children on foot or by bike, we request you to park in the designated parking spaces in such a way that traffic is not hindered and safety is not compromised. The police are warned about violations of the parking bans. The police are regularly asked by the IKC to supervise. In connection with the safety of the children, there is an entry ban at the Ina Boudier-Bakkerstraat between 8.15-8.45 and 14.45-15.15 hours. At the Roland Holstlaan we ask you not to stop in front of the RH building. There are sufficient parking places at the Roland Holstlaan and the Jan Campertlaan. We also ask your child to come to school by bicycle only if it is necessary. There is only limited space for the IKC to store bicycles. That is why only children

who live more than a quarter of an hour away from the school are allowed to cycle to school.

If your child does come to school by bike, we ask you to put them in the appropriate stands. Make sure that the bicycle is locked. The IKC is not liable for damage and/or theft.

School trips

With every IPC theme we try to make a trip. This is communicated in advance to parent(s) via the newsletter, a separate letter or e-mail.

During trips, regular use is made of transport by parents. Parents who transport children by car must have a passenger insurance policy and seat belts, also in the back. Children up to 1.35 m should preferably be transported in an approved child seat. The law makes exceptions for occasional transport by others than the parents. Children up to 1.35 m, however, cannot be transported on the front seat without an approved child seat. We adhere to the guidelines for safe transport. In the case of transport by other parent(s), we ask you to give your child a car seat (if present) for use during transport during the trip. Many trips can only happen with the help of parent(s). Please reserve time for this!

Suspension and removal

In consultation with the Librijn Foundation, the school has drawn up clear rules for suspension and removal in case of unacceptable behaviour of children and/or parent(s) and when the teachers and staff at the school no longer can supply the care necessary for the child in question. We use a behaviour protocol for this. This protocol can be found on our website.

Under unacceptable behaviour we mean:

- not listening to instructions from teachers and staff;
- refusing to participate in activities;
- een grote mond hebben of brutaal zijn;
- having a big mouth or being rude; to insult, discriminate, swear, scold, threaten;
- fighting, hitting and kicking;
- bullying;
- vandalism and/or theft;
- regular tardiness.

The definition of the case of lack of adequate actions by the school:

The situation that arises when the school in general can no longer give an adequate approach to the specific instructional and educational needs of a child. Suspension means denial of access to the school for one day.

Removal means that the child is deregistered from the school. In all cases, all involve parties will be heard. The competent authority is involved in the procedure. Final removal can only take place once the management of the school has ensured that another school or institution is prepared to admit the child, with a maximum term of eight weeks.

This suspension and removal policy also applies when parent(s) show aggressive and intimidating behaviour towards other parent(s), teachers, management, other staff members and/or children of the school.

In the event of a violation of any law, we, as IKC, always involve the police.

Swim2Play

Group 5 through 8 participates in Swim2Play. For a period of 5 weeks, in turns each class will go to the pool once a week for a 'wet gym class'. In that period the gym classes on Mondays and Tuesdays will be cancelled.

Swim2Play is learning swimming skills in a playful manner. Children need to be able to save themselves around water, in the swimming pool, the sea or the

lake. There is a difference with ABC swimming lessons because the skills are learned in a playful way.

Toilet trained

We assume that children who attend primary school are toilet trained. The fact that children in kindergarten age sometimes have an 'accident' is normal, so you should bring spare clothing. If your child is not toilet trained for medical reasons, we will try to find a solution together with you as a parent. As a school we only change children in case of an accident.

Vruit (Gruit)

As an IKC, we encourage healthy eating. During the break we aim to ensure that children eat and drink healthily. We have Vruit-days three times a week at school on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. This means that only fruit and/or vegetables are eaten at school during the small break. We celebrate your child's birthday in class and at childcare. Of course your child will receive the opportunity to treat. A small amount is desirable here and we strongly support a healthy treat for the children and the teachers / pedagogical staff.
