Leave

We are sometimes asked questions or encounter confusion regarding leave.

The information below provides further clarification.

This can also be found in our school guide.

Apart from in the case of illness, it is not permitted to miss school. Extra leave for holidays is therefore not allowed. Children have 13 weeks of holidays. You have plenty of time to go on holiday together during this period. There is only one exception, namely if one of the parents is unable to take time off during any of

the school holidays. In such cases, a statement from the employer must be provided. The school management is obliged to follow these rules and, in the event of a breach, to report this to the truancy officer.

You may apply for a day's leave for a child in exceptional circumstances, such as a house move, religious holidays, a family member's wedding or an anniversary.

You can apply for leave via Social Schools.

An application must be submitted to the headteacher at least one month before the desired leave. You will receive a response to your request within fourteen days.

Extra holiday leave during the first two weeks of term following the school holidays is never permitted. Unauthorised absence must be reported to the school attendance officer.
