Tardiness

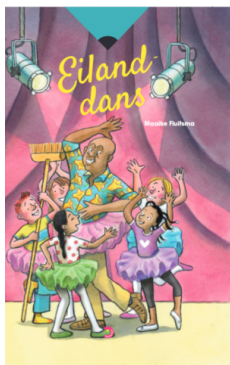

Leave of absence

Sometimes we get questions or confusion about leave.

The following information gives you more clarity. This can also be found in our school guide.

Except in case of illness, it is not permitted to miss school hours. Extra leave for holidays is not allowed. Children have 13 weeks of holidays. You have enough time to celebrate holidays together. There is only one exception, namely when one of the parents cannot be away during any of the school holidays. An employer's statement must then be submitted. The management is obliged to follow these rules and in case of violation to report this to the school official.



You can request a day off for a child in case of important circumstances, such as moving house, religious holidays, a marriage of a family member or an anniversary. The form 'request for exemption from school attendance' can be

downloaded from the website:

A request form must be submitted to the integral school leader at least one month before the desired leave. You will receive an answer to your request within fourteen days.

Extra leave in the first two weeks after the school holiday is never allowed. Unauthorised absence must be reported to the school attendance officer.

School Meals Programme - grocery card

Our school is participating in the School Meals Programme. The letter below provides more information on this. You cannot click on the blue links in this letter. Please go to Google and type this into your search bar yourself. Please, scroll down to read the letter.

Dear parent/caregiver,

Your child(ren)'s school is participating in the School Meals Programme and has chosen for the grocery cards. **This means that you can register for a grocery card.** With this programme, we hope to ensure that all students have enough to eat when going to school. After all, a full belly improves their learning capacity. All the parents/caregivers at your school have received this message. The grocery card

In the registration form, we will ask you some questions about your situation at home. If your answers show that you could use some extra support, you will receive the grocery card. Twice a month, the amount of €25 per child will be added to your card. With this money, you can buy food for your child(ren) until the end of 2024. The grocery card works like any other debit card and can be used in almost any supermarket in the Netherlands, as well as other stores that sell food, such as bakeries, markets, and stores with international food products ("toko's"). Note: the card can only be used for food and does not work in online stores, drugstores, liquor stores, clothing stores, etc.

Frequently asked questions

1) Who will know of my registration?

Your registration will stay confidential. We care about your privacy. The school will only check the number of children that you have registered. No one at school will know about your registration. The Red Cross will see the information that is necessary to support you and will not share this with the government or other organisations.

2) Am I eligible for the grocery card?

Groceries have become expensive for everyone. We would like to help parents/caregivers who sometimes worry about money or would like to provide healthier or more varied food for their children.

In the registration form, we will ask you a few questions about your home situation. All the parents/caregivers of the school may fill in the form. Do you still have doubts? Call/SMS/WhatsApp our customer service (097 010 204 851).

3) I have children attending different schools, what should I do?

Every school that is taking part in the grocery card programme has its own registration link. Children can only be registered through the link of their own school.

4) I'm on welfare, what should I do?

If you receive social welfare benefits ("bijstandsuitkering"), you can check with your municipality what your limit is for receiving gifts to ensure that you do not surpass this. We are looking for an exception to the applicable rules for this programme and will keep you updated on our website.
