Learning to get dressed and undressed in kindergarten

Will you help?

Would you please practise dressing and undressing with your child at home? For example, practising putting shoes on and taking them off, fixing the sleeves of a jumper or


jacket so that they are not inside out. Same with trousers. Opening and closing a zip, buttons...This is not learned in 1 day, but regular practice is nice. Of course, the teachers lend a

hand where necessary, such as tying laces, etc. We also encourage the children to help each other, but the more children who can do this independently, the more time is left over for our PE lessons, outdoor playtime, etc.

Cutting with scissors

Please help your child practise cutting with scissors. We see big differences among the children in handling scissors and 'cutting' with them. Do you practise at home? There is nothing better than cutting snippets and then sticking them on with a brush and glue. Moreover, cutting is an important skill that you use regularly. Not only for cutting paper, for example, but also for better learning of other skills. Cutting requires coordination where both sides of the body have to work together and it requires fine motor strength in the hand, thumb and fingers. You also need all these skills for, among other things, learning to tie laces, button a coat, twist a lid on your cup, develop good handwriting, etc.











FLL has started

Once again this year, a group of enthusiastic children from 7 and 8 are taking part in the First Lego League. On Sunday mornings, under the guidance of very enthusiastic parents, the group works on missions that the robot performs. In



addition to the missions, a research project has to be carried out and the children come up with their own innovation project. The Delft final will take place in January 2025. We will keep you updated on the progress and state of play.

language development of (young) children. It lends to an increase in their vocabulary and sentence structure, and trains their listening skills. Their pleasure in listening, and later reading books themselves is increased in this



pleasant way. We would like to thank everyone who came to read to us and we hope to see you again next time.


