#### Week of Media Literacy

Last week was The Week of Media Literacy.

During this week, the children in groups 5 to 8 had a workshop by Sylvia Dijkshoorn. She has her own practice where she treats children and adults using emotion therapy. She also gives workshops and training sessions.

A message with more information about the workshops given at school has been

posted on Social Schools. The upper school also participated in the national MediaMasters competition.

During the national MediaMasters competition, pupils are challenged for five game days to help the protagonists in the game. To do this, they can complete MediaMissions in class and at home.
