Wanted

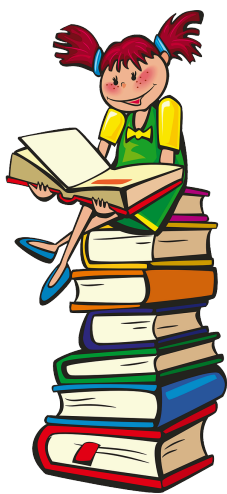
