Report the child care organization's new 2024 hourly rates to Toeslagen as soon as possible for the 2024 child care benefit. Report the actual hourly rate, even if it is above the maximum hourly rate. This information is important for the government to have a good understanding of the actual cost of child care. If the number of hours of care or your income changes in 2024, change this immediately as well. Or will your salary change? You can also report these changes so that you do not receive too much allowance and have to pay it back. Use our childcare allowance explanation app. Step-by-step you will be guided through the Toeslagen website in understandable language. You will get explanations and help on how to apply for the childcare allowance or make a change. The app is available in 6 languages: Dutch, English, Polish, Arabic, Ukrainian and Russian.

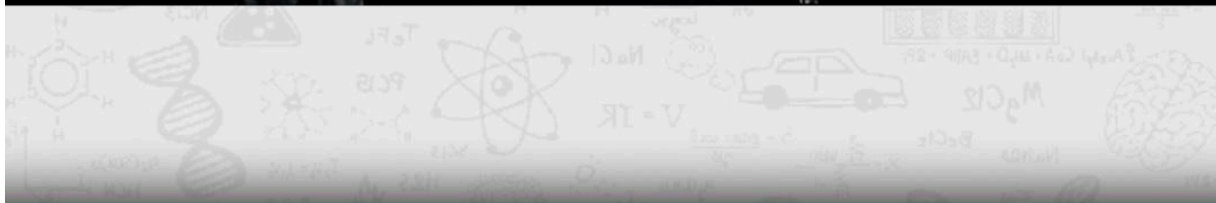
